This webinar will provide essential insights into anti-doping rules, coaches' responsibilities, and practical ways to support athletes while protecting themselves and promoting clean sport. A live Q&A session will also be included.

His contribution will enrich the discussion and we believe it will encourage fellow coaches to actively engage in this important educational initiative.

The webinar will be delivered in **English**, with simultaneous translation into **French and Spanish**. Participants will receive a PDF of the presentation, including links to additional resources.
